








SELDAD SECAPACITIES



- 1 Hanger Node capacity: 4000 lbs.
- Hang within 3 inches of any Upper Panel point for a maximum load of **2500 lbs**.
- Hang a maximum load of **500 lbs**. at any location on Upper Chord.

The **MAXIMUM** allowable live load on any one truss is **5500 lbs**.

DO NOT use Traditional c-clamps on truss. Only use 2" aluminum theatrical truss couplers (cheeseboro).

DO NOT wrap the aluminum rigging grid with unprotected cable. Only use steelflex wire rope slings or approved protected cable to wrap truss.

DO NOT rig from access bridges.

DO NOT cut or drill through any member.

Any steel or dissimilar metal used to support hanging loads in contact with the aluminum truss shall be either galvanized and/or wrapped with a sufficient barrier to protect the aluminum truss from corrosion.



To order a hard line internet drop or phone line anywhere in the building, you will need to schedule this through Century Link (855) 891-4083 at least 2-3 weeks prior to your event and have the installation scheduled for the event load-in day.

Tacoma Dome Wi-Fi Service

The Tacoma Dome offers complimentary Wi-Fi to all guests. Guests only need to connect to Dome-Public to use this service. Dome-Public has a variable level of bandwidth associated with it and has no guarantee of upload or download speeds available.

Should an event want a dedicated level of up/download speeds they should consider one of two options:

 Access to SSID Dome-BOH: This password protected option provides 10 or 20 Mbps up/down speeds to events that are only concerned about a reliable, dedicated service. TACOMA DOME FOODSERVICE POLICY

CATERING: All catering must be performed by the Tacoma Dome's contracted caterer, Centerplate Catering, unless agreement to the contrary is reached in writing no fewer than ten (10) days prior to the event. This includes, but is not limited to, crew feeds, vendor lounges, and outdoor events, including Tacoma Dome parking lots and the plaza area.

CONCESSIONS: The Tacoma Dome retains the exclusive right to operate all food and beverage concessions on the premises, including the Arena, Exhibition Hall, parking lots, and plaza area. Promoters shall not allow, or cause, beverages, food of any kind, beer, wine, liquor, or tobacco products to be sold, given away, or used at the Tacoma Dome without the express written consent of the Tacoma Dome. The Tacoma Dome reserves the right to sell, at its discretion, any concession items that are appropriate to the event.

SAMPLES: No free samples of food, beverages, or any other product may be given away or otherwise distributed without prior written approval of the Tacoma Dome and the Tacoma Dome's contracted concessionaire, Centerplate. Sampled products must not interfere with exclusive sponsorship agreements set forth by the Tacoma Dome's marketing department. The Tacoma Dome reserves the right to restrict the location, time, and serving size of the sampled product.

Serving Size

Beverages – 2 oz. Food Products – 2 oz.

Times

At the conclusion of the event, unless agreed upon in advance by the Tacoma Dome.

Locations

Exit doors, unless agreed upon in advance by the Tacoma Dome. Sampling locations must not interfere with concessionaire's portable carts, permanent stands, and/or merchandise stands.

Trash Disposal

It is the sampler's responsibility to rid the sampling area of all debris, and to haul away all product packaging material. The Tacoma Dome reserves the right to further request additional cleaning if necessary.

Sampling Request Forms

Must be submitted for approval by the Tacoma Dome and Centerplate.

FLOOR SPACE: Promoters shall not allow vendor booths or displays to block or prevent access to Tacoma Dome concession stands. Please contact your Tacoma Dome Event Manager to discuss any details involving your event layout.

PARKING LOT EVENTS: Catering, concessions and sampling policies apply to all parking lot events.

THIRD PARTY RESPONSIBILITY: It is the responsibility of the Promoter to inform any third party vendors, or sponsors of the Tacoma Dome's foodservice policies. **Please remind your exhibitors that no outside food or beverage will be permitted inside the Tacoma Dome.** In cases where a conflict arises with agreements that the Promoter has with a third party, the policies of the Tacoma Dome shall prevail.
